
Is that not reason enough to act now?





### Create framework for exchange of information & experience on prevention & disposal of OPs


- Commonly agreed information exchange mechanism among participating stakeholders;

#### Field works:

- Safeguarding of at least one high risk
   OPs / POPs stock;
- Securing storages in 3 countries;
- Training of 1 to 2 trainers per country on management of OPs and POPs
- Training to make inventories

### First results till today:

- Over the period of 1 year
- We trained more than 80 persons from the region on:
- Awareness Raising
- Being a trainer
- Training of inventory
